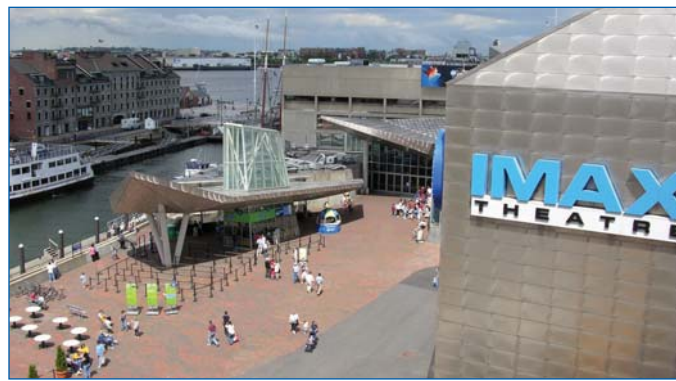
Edge of the Sea Tidepool
