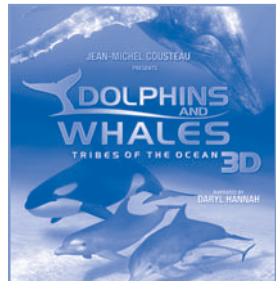

Restrooms Located to the left of the Information Desk and on Level 2 of the IMAX Theatre. Family restrooms are near the Café.

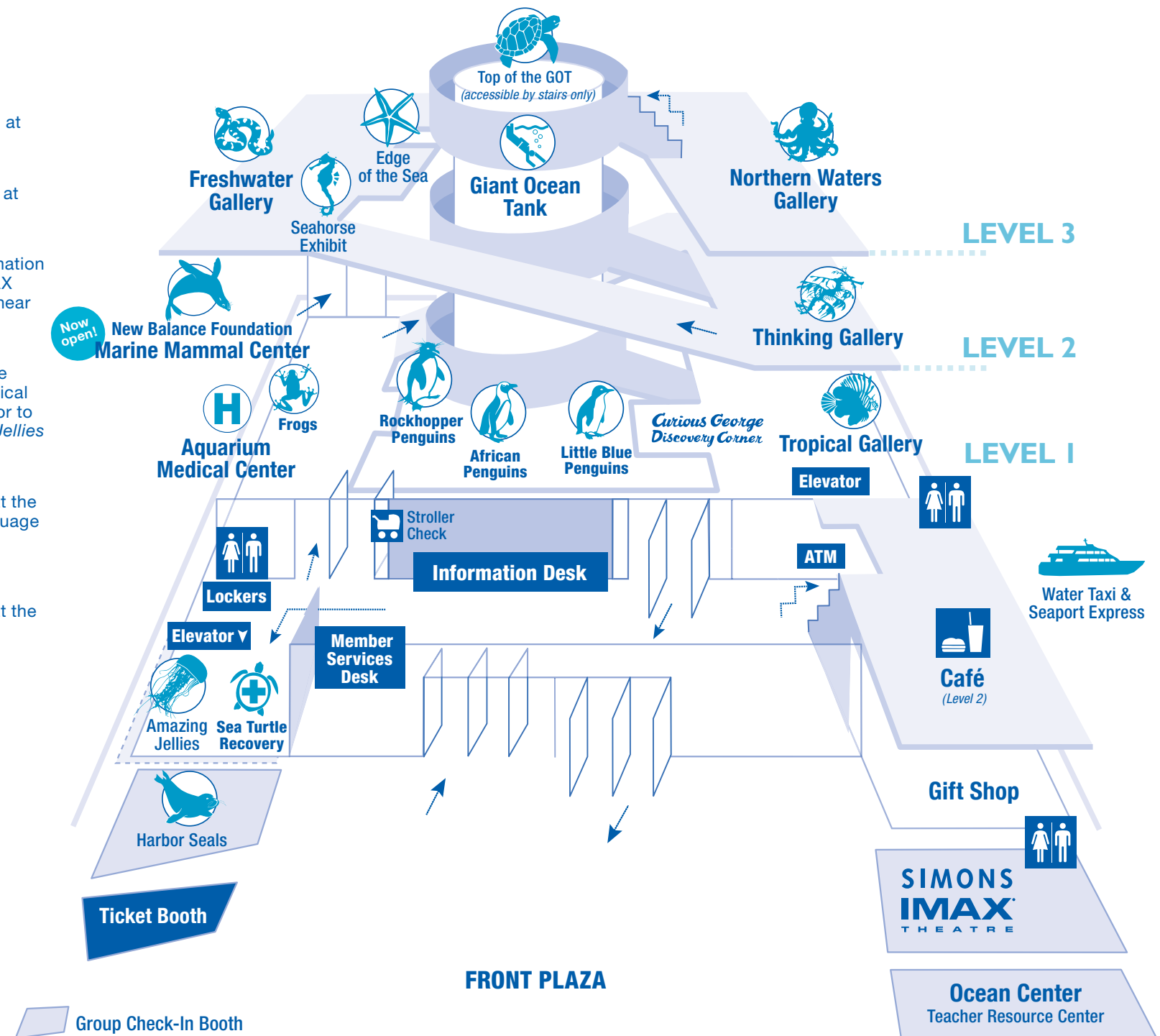

Don't Miss a Thing!

Follow this path to best enjoy the exhibits.

Amazing Jellies Turn left after entering the lobby to find out how these gelatinous creatures without brains are taking over our oceans.

Say hello to the **African penguins** as you enter the main building.

Check on our patients in the **Aquarium Medical Center**.

Thinking Gallery Try interactive exhibits and learn about giant groupers and tiny seadragons.

Freshwater Gallery See piranha, anaconda, salmon and an electric eel.

Edge of the Sea Tidepool Get your hands wet meeting sea stars, hermit crabs and sea urchins. Opens at 9:30 a.m.

Seahorse exhibit These animals are masters of camouflage, and the male seahorses are the ones who become pregnant and give birth!

Northern Waters Gallery Explore the Gulf of Maine exhibit and see an octopus, sea anemones and fish from the Pacific West Coast.

Giant Ocean Tank Take the stairs to the top and walk down the spiral, looking through the 67 windows at the 675+ animals inside.

Tropical Gallery At the bottom of the ramp, you'll see colorful clownfish, tangs, lionfish, flashlight fish and live coral.

See **rockhopper penguins**, the ones that jump in the water feet first.

Visit **little blue penguins**, the smallest in the world.

Get up close to the Northern fur seals and see these athletic animals in action at the **New Balance Foundation Marine Mammal Center**.
