Chrysocome II	Br R	F	11/7/00	---- came from SeaWorld Nov 2009	----	The species name for the southern rockhopper penguin, which is “golden hair” in Greek. Together with the genus name their scientific name means “golden haired diver”
Terhalten	Pk	F	12/9/05	---- came from SeaWorld Nov 2009	----	Named after the captain of the Dutch ship “Mauritius” Johan Ter Halte, Isla Terhalten along with Isla Sesambre are located about six miles south of Lennox Island. Their high, rocky, ocean facing cliffs make these two islands ideal southern rockhopper breeding islands.
Sesambre	W	F	12/16/07	---- came from SeaWorld Nov 2009	----	Sesambre and Terhalten are two small islands with high, rocky, ocean facing cliffs located about six miles south of Lennox Island. This harsh terrain is actually very ideal breeding areas for the southern rockhopper.
Tussock	Y/Bk R	F	12/6/06	---- came from SeaWorld Nov 2009	----	A tall, dense, hardy grass that is native to South America and the Falkland Islands. It is found on many preferred rockhopper breeding islands and provides protection from land and air predators
