NEW Indo-Pacific Coral Reef

View brilliantly colored tropical fish darting and swimming across the lush seascape of our 9,000-gallon, floor-to-ceiling, concave habitat. The immersive and captivating exhibit, which accentuates the dazzling colors of the ocean, helps visitors learn about these “rainforests of the sea” that are so essential to supporting thousands of species of fish, sea turtles, sharks, and other marine life.

New England Aquarium Whale Watch



See whales, dolphins, seabirds, and other marine life aboard a high-speed catamaran with three outside decks for optimal viewing.

Penguins

Dozens of penguins populate our rockhopper and African penguin colonies. Watch them hop, dive, and fly through the water.



Giant Ocean Tank

Wind around the four-story Caribbean reef and watch sea turtles, eels, stingrays, and hundreds of tropical fish navigate this 200,000-gallon centerpiece exhibit.



Edge of the Sea Tidepool Touch Tank

Touch a sea star and hermit crab, pet a horseshoe crab, and feel a periwinkle tickle your fingertip.



Giant Pacific Octopus

Spot this eight-armed giant in its cave-like home. This captivating animal can change colors depending on its surroundings or mood.



Seadragons

These mesmerizing fish in disguise may fool you at first glance. Find them among the foliage and learn where these animals live in the wild.



Sea Jellies

Observe otherworldly jellies with no brains or bones, and find out why these dangerous beauties are taking over our oceans.



Harbor Seals

Get some face time with our playful harbor seals! Watch them glide through the water and loll around on the rocks in our front plaza exhibit.

Feel the smooth wing of a friendly cownose ray or touch a passing epaulette shark in this mangrove-themed tank surrounded by shallow edges and viewing windows.
