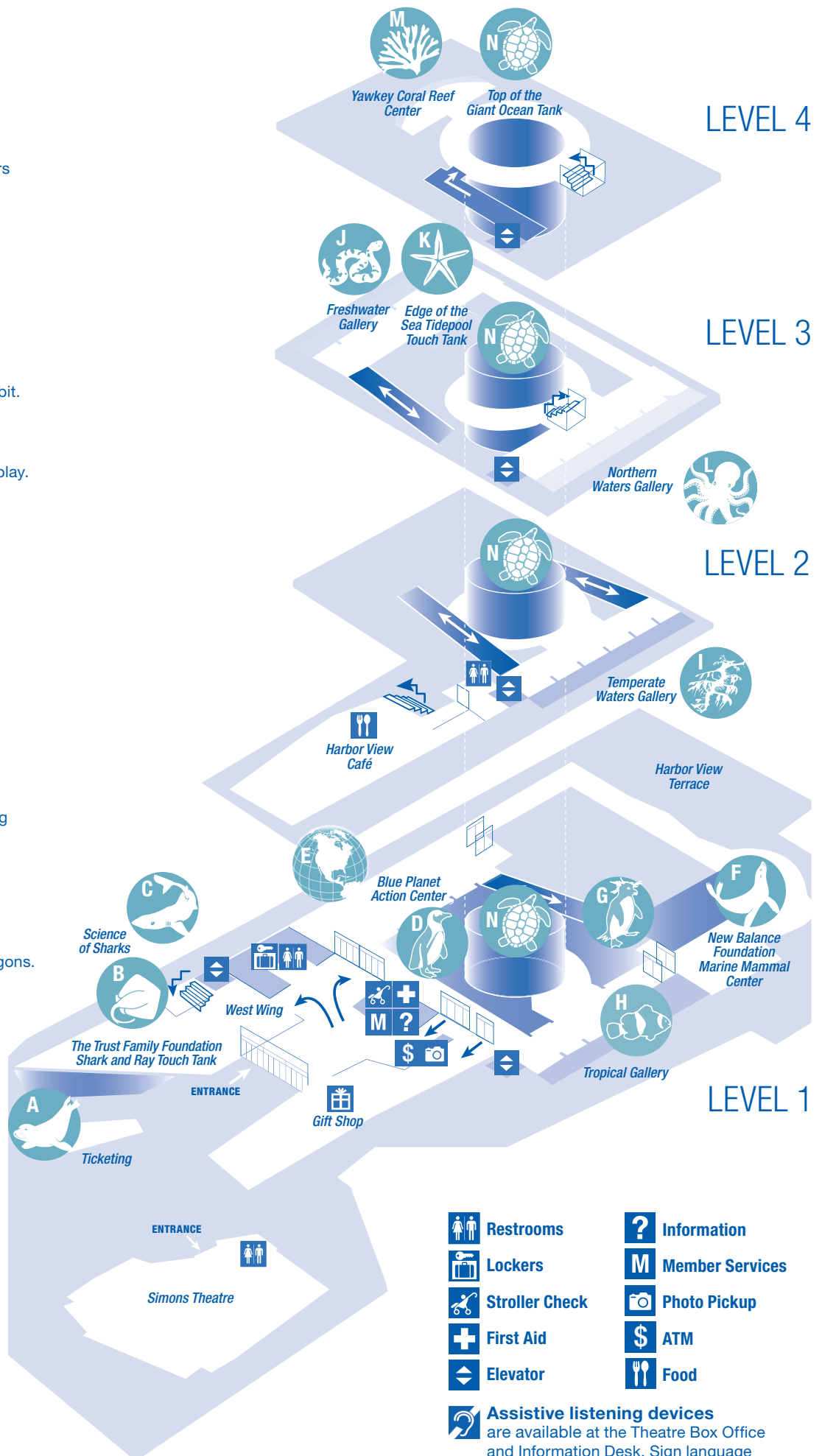
Yawkey Coral Reef Center
