Check out our mangrove-themed exhibit with cownose rays, Atlantic rays, and epaulette sharks.
- C Science of Sharks***
Get up close to some small but mighty shark species and discover their remarkable adaptations in this new exhibit.
- D African Penguins**
Watch these charming birds preen and play.
- E Blue Planet Action Center**
Learn about challenges facing the blue planet and the Aquarium's leading role in ocean conservation.

LEVEL 2

- F Temperate Waters Gallery**
See giant groupers and delicate seadragons.

LEVEL 3

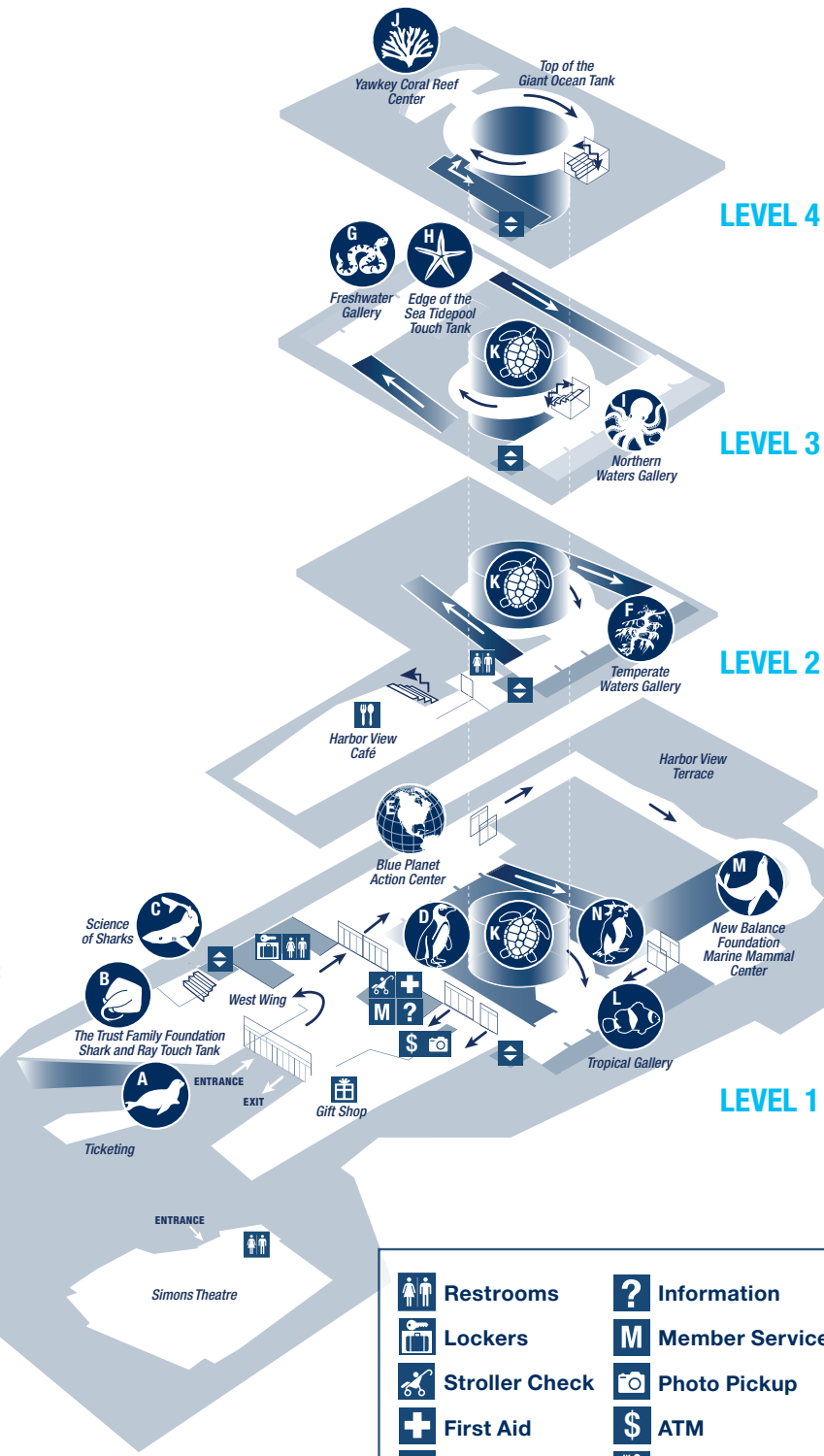
- G Freshwater Gallery**
See piranha, anaconda, salmon, and an electric eel.
- H Edge of the Sea Tidepool***
Meet sea stars, hermit crabs, and sea urchins.
- I Northern Waters Gallery**

- J Yawkey Coral Reef Center**
See a variety of Caribbean species, including gently swaying garden eels.
- K Giant Ocean Tank**
Walk around the spiral ramp to watch turtles—including Myrtle the green sea turtle—and colorful fishes swim around the coral reef.

- L Tropical Gallery**
See colorful clownfish, lionfish, and live coral.
- M New Balance Foundation Marine Mammal Center**
Get up close to the northern fur seals and California sea lions.
- N Rockhopper Penguins**
See the penguins with the yellow crests.
