Programs for Teens

live blue™ Ambassadors

(Ages 14 – 18)

The *live blue*™ Ambassadors program is a field conservation program for teens who are interested in serving the Aquarium's mission beyond the walls of the Aquarium. Participants may take part in habitat cleanup and restoration, invasive species removal, and citizen science. All new participants are required to attend a one-hour orientation at the Aquarium prior to their first event. Locations and times vary by event and are listed in the weekly update emails.

Marine Biologist in Training Programs
